Report

Members will be aware that 14 May is the 50th Anniversary of the signing of the Twinning agreement between Rouen and Norwich. Last autumn, after discussions with Norfolk and Norwich Rouen Friendship Association we invited the Lord Mayor of Rouen to consider a twinning weekend of activities in Norwich to celebrate the anniversary. The weekend chosen was 22 May to 24 May 2009.

The initial plans for the weekend are for the Norfolk and Norwich Rouen Friendship Association to host an evening on the Friday where the Norfolk and Norwich Rouen Friendship and other participating groups will undertake activities. A Civic dinner will be held on the Saturday evening.

Unfortunately, due to the fact that Rouen was unable to identify their preferred weekend until January, the number of groups able to take part is smaller than originally hoped. As well as the Civic party, several members from Rouen's two five-a –side football teams and a veterans rugby team will be coming.

Discussions are on going with several other groups who have not been able to commit to this weekend and it is hoped that their visits will happen another time.
