Report

Background

- 1. This is one of a series of reports that have been produced regularly since 2008. The purpose of this report is to ensure members are aware of the outcome of planning appeals.
- 2. Appendix 1a provides details of appeals lodged which are pending. There are eight planning appeals pending or awaiting decision. Seven of these appeals were delegated officer decisions where the application was refused. The remaining one appeal (application number 12/01120/VC for moorings at King St) was a case where members overturned the officers' recommendation and refused the application.
- 4. There was one appeal dismissed during this quarter (Appendix 1b). The case was a delegated officer decision which was approved and the appellant appealed against conditions imposed on the planning permission.
- 5. As shown in Appendix 1c there have been two appeals allowed. Both cases were delegated officer decisions where the application had been refused.
- 6. Application 11/00193/F was for an "urban green point" on-street recycling device at the junction of Ipswich Road and Ipswich Grove. The Inspector considered the impact on the character and appearance of the area and highway safety. He did not consider that there was "an adverse effect on views into and out of the conservation area and would not materially harm the character and appearance of the ... streetscene". In terms of highway safety he did not consider there was any harm as the proposal is aimed at pedestrians and unlikely to attract car traffic and parking and as the footway would be unimpeded by its installation.
- 6. Application 11/01332/RM related to reserved matters of appearance landscaping, layout and scale of consent for a restaurant. The main issues were the effect on trees and the proposed cycle parking. As the appellant submitted an Arboricultural Implications Assessment (AIA) at the appeal stage and the council regarded this as satisfactory then the council withdrew 2 of the reasons for refusal. The council then accepted that the third reason (cycle parking) could be dealt with by condition. The council submitted a claim for costs against the appellant as it considered that their behaviour was unreasonable and caused the council to incur or waste expense unnecessarily. The need for an AIA was identified at a very early stage and their agent specifically request requested that the application be validated as they considered that the tree information was sufficient to determine the application. The Inspector decided that the "it is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that it has submitted the necessary information as part of a planning application and thus the council did not act unreasonably in refusing permission in advance of the 8 week date" without the AIA. Costs were awarded against the appellant.

 Since 30 September two of the appeals in progress have also been decided. These are 1 City Road (application no. 12/00377/F) and Land to the southwest of 1-9 Catton View Court (application no. 11/00735/O) which were both dismissed.
