Political imperative for an integrated approach

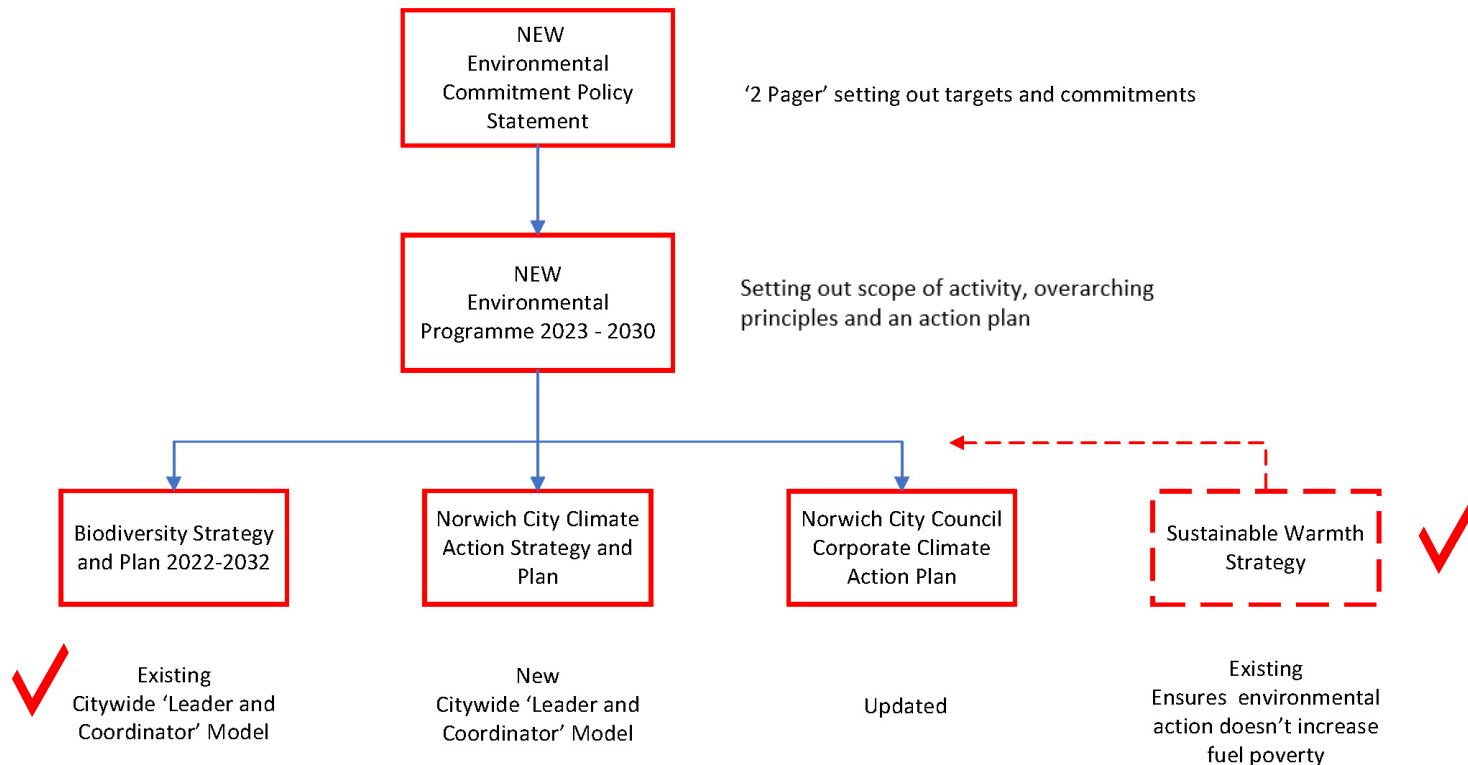

Similar Biodiversity Emergency motion passed in September 2019

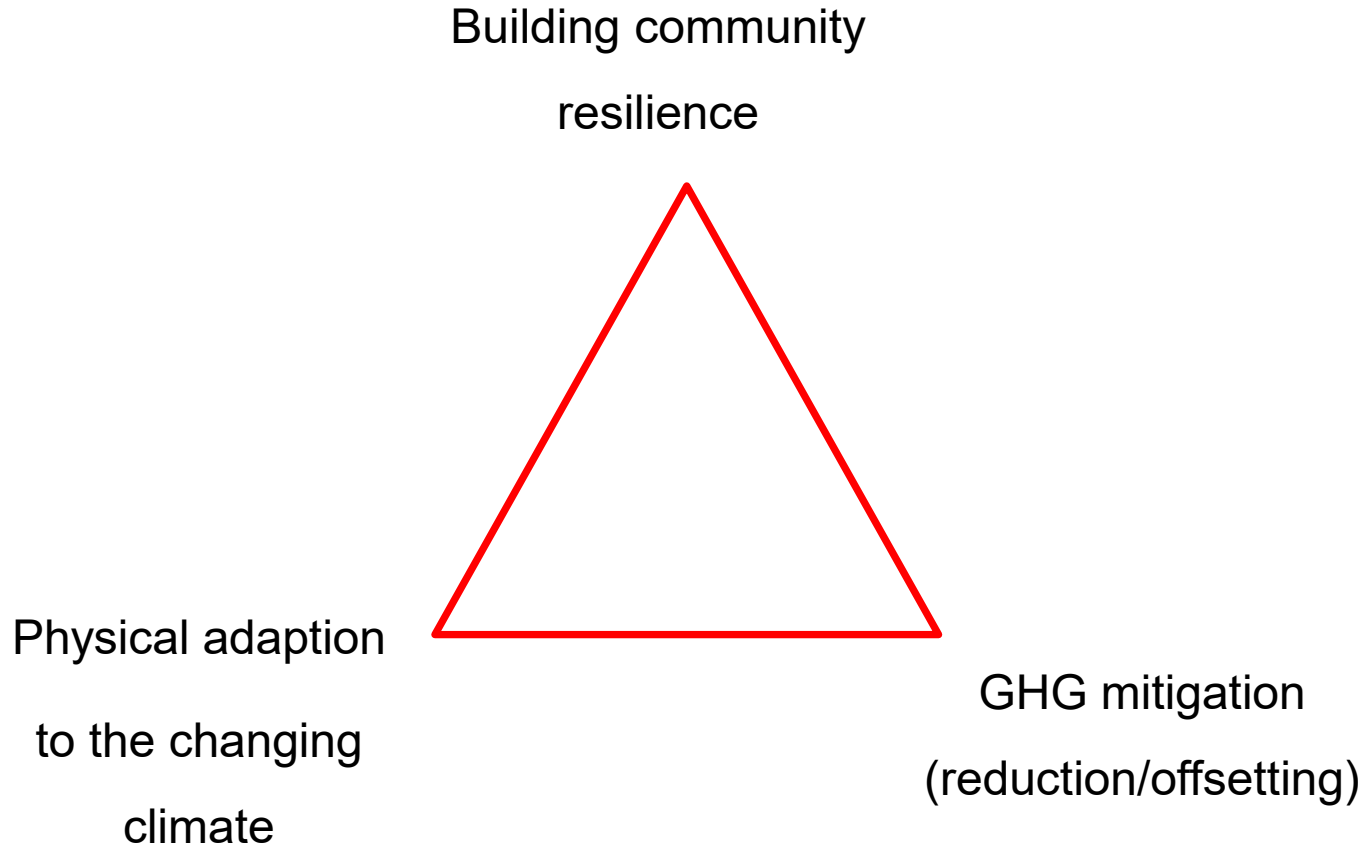
The need to integrate environmental and socioeconomic strategy and activities is acknowledged

Environmental Policy, Strategy and Action

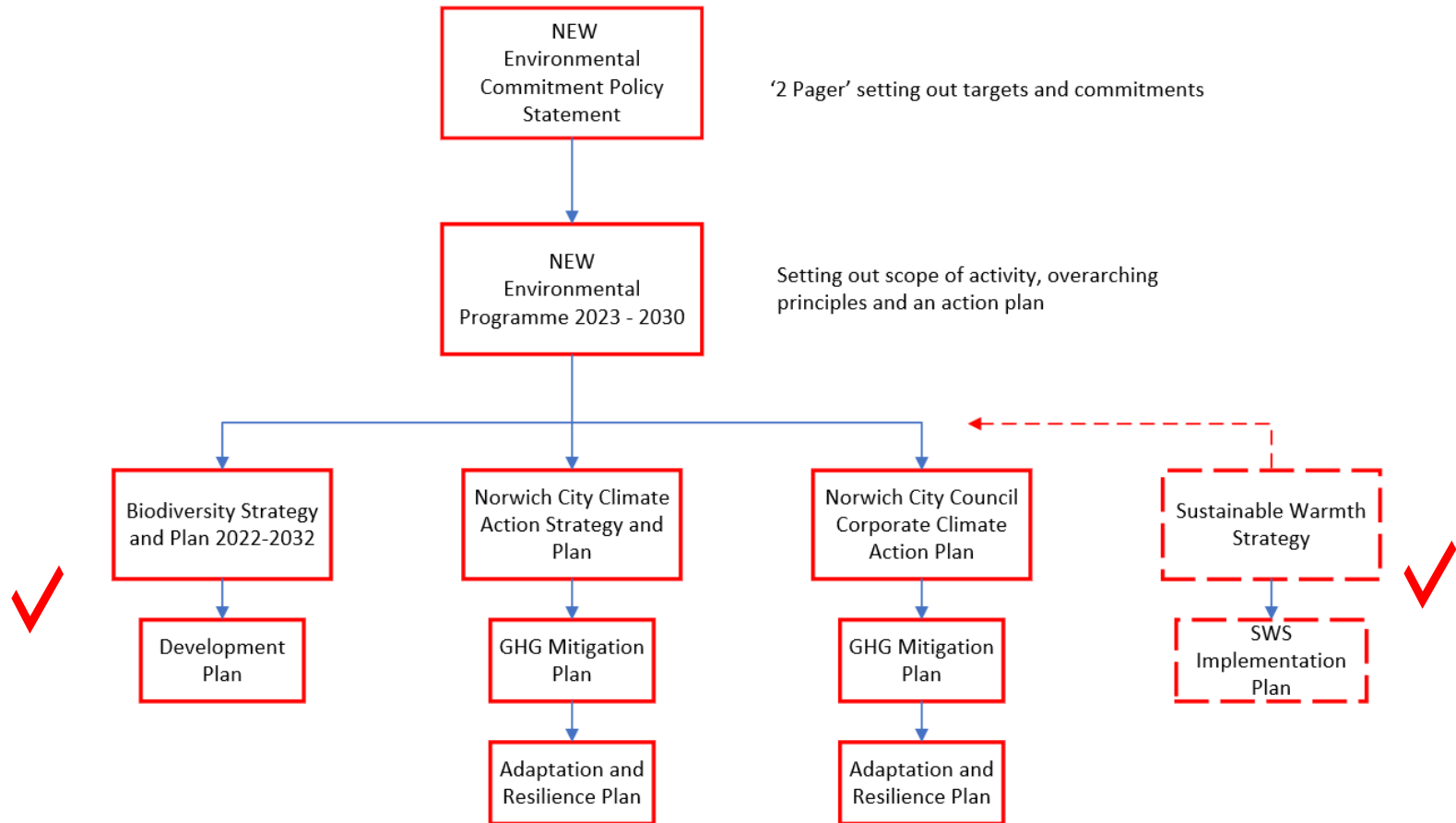
The focus will be on environmental policy, strategy and action but with reference to socioeconomic linkages and opportunities, through a suite of documents



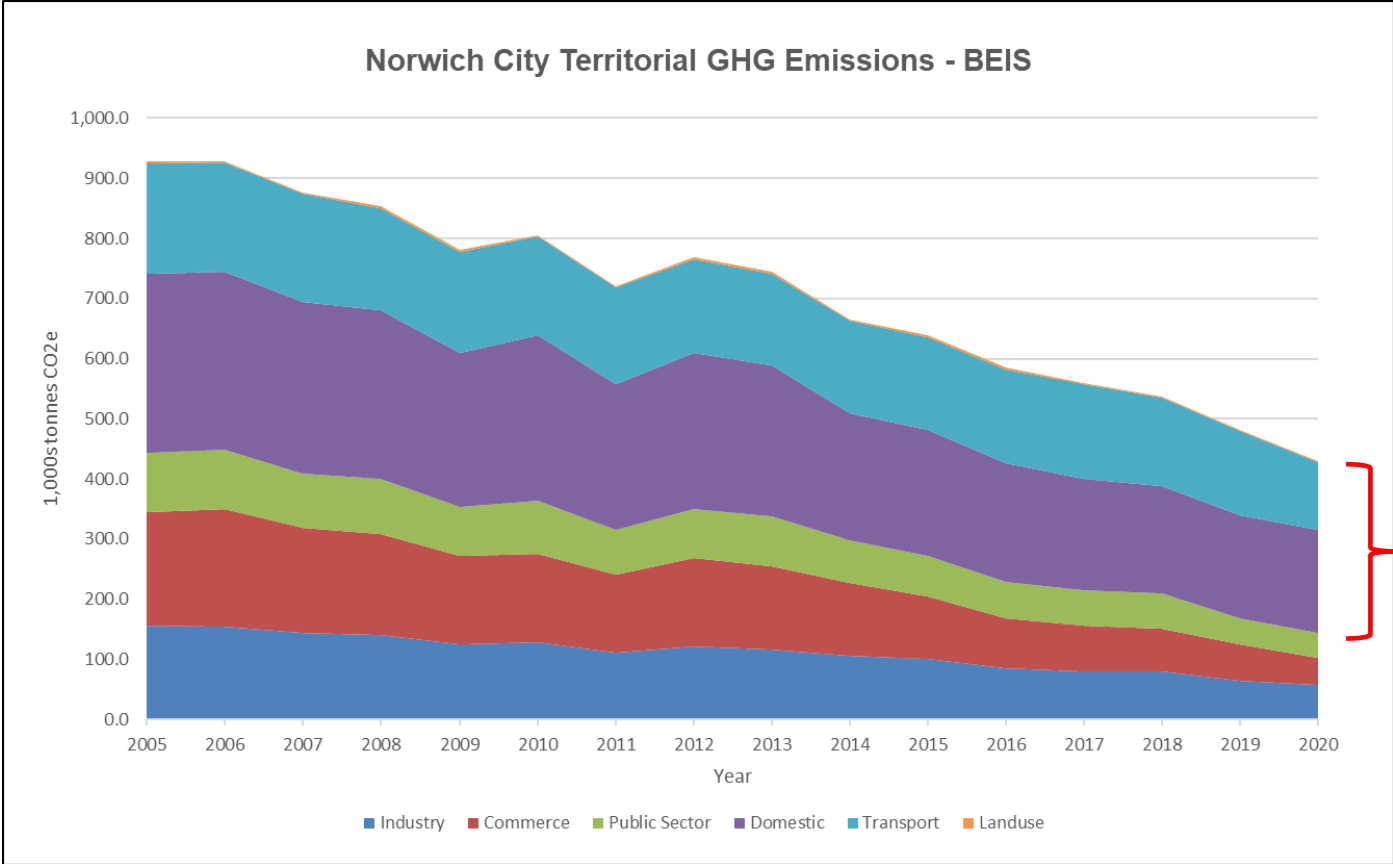
Citywide Climate Action Plan – main tenets

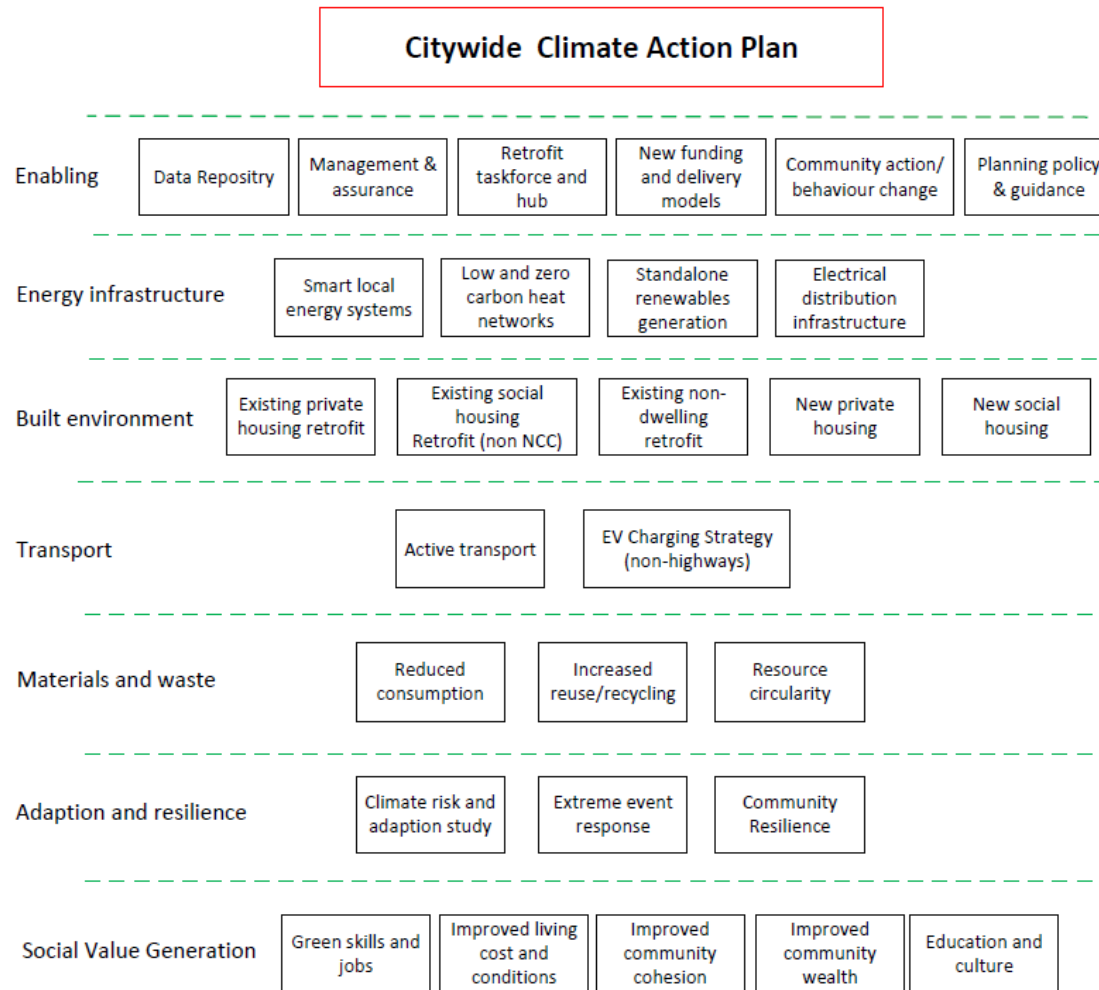


Citywide Climate Action Plan - based on evidence

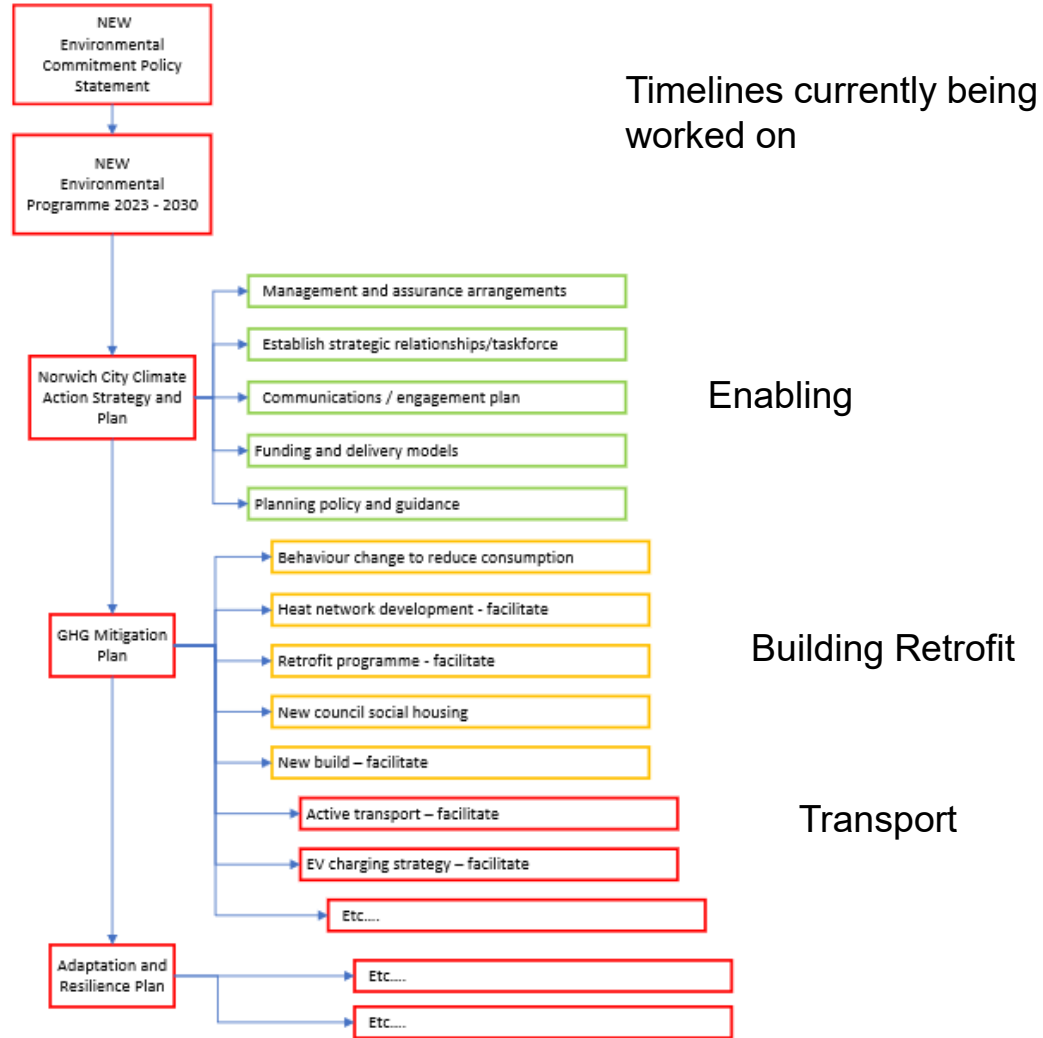

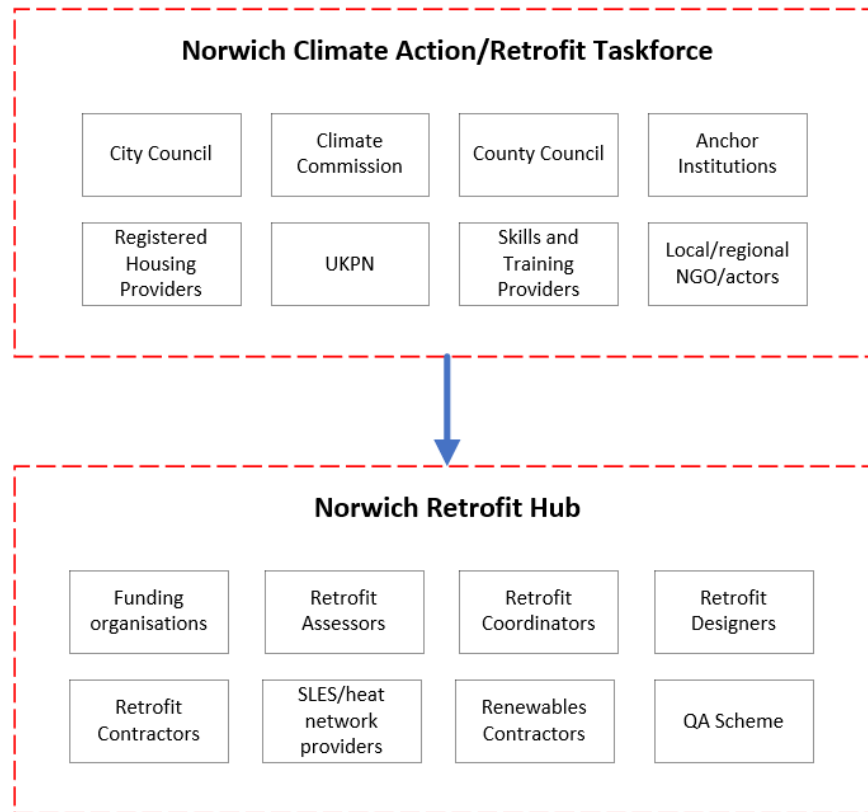
Citywide Climate Action Plan – scope



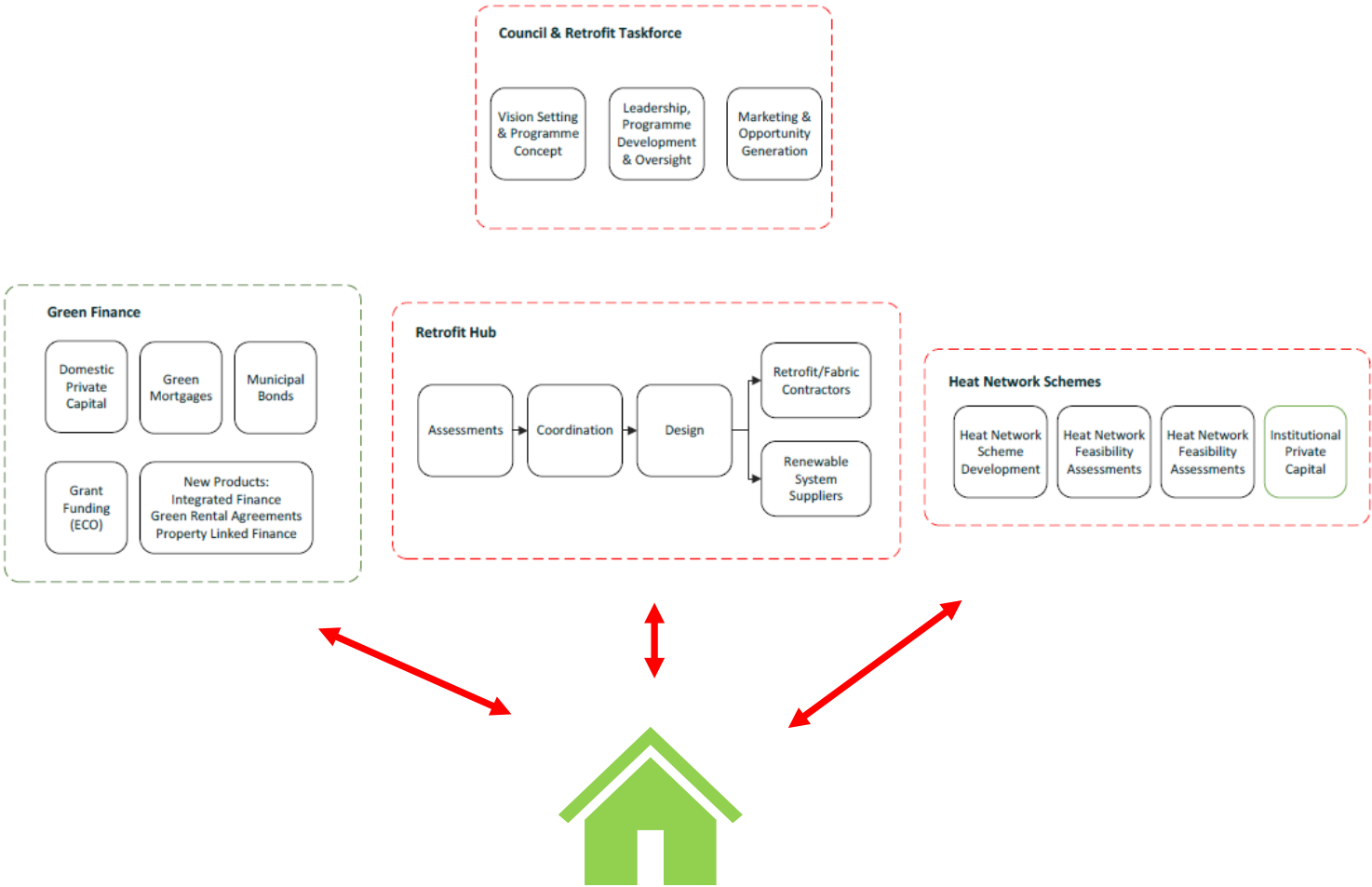
Citywide Climate Action Plan development



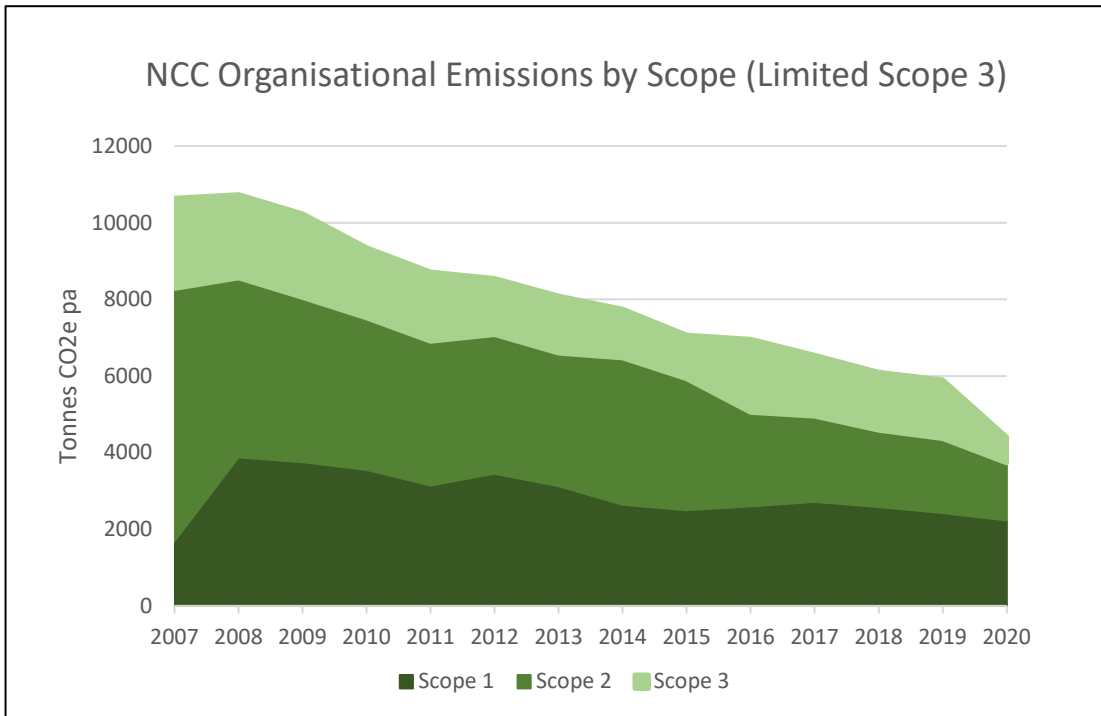
Citywide strategic structures and relationships - proposed

Scope 1

Process emissions (owned buildings)

- Data obtained from contractor's energy records (kWh)

Fuel use (owned vehicles)

- Data obtained from fuel invoices (litres)

Scope 2

Electricity emissions (own buildings)

- Data obtained from utility bills (kWh)

Electricity emissions (contractor-operated buildings)

- Data obtained from contractor's energy records (kWh)

Scope 3

Business travel (grey fleet and contractor)

- Data taken from officer and member business mileage claim forms (km)
- Data taken from contractor business mileage records (km)

Public transport

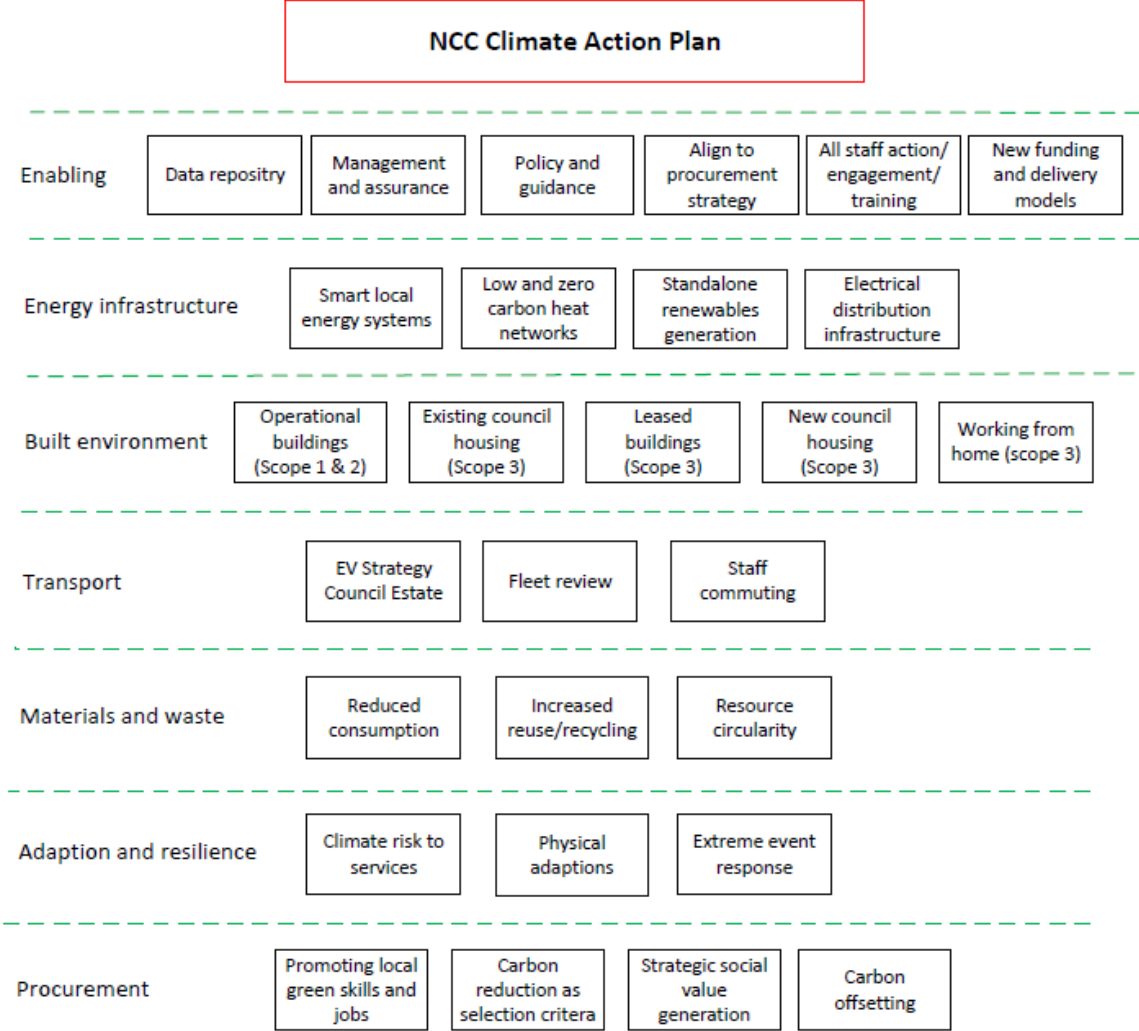
- Data taken from officer and member business mileage claim forms (km)
- Data for train journeys taken from rail account invoices (km)

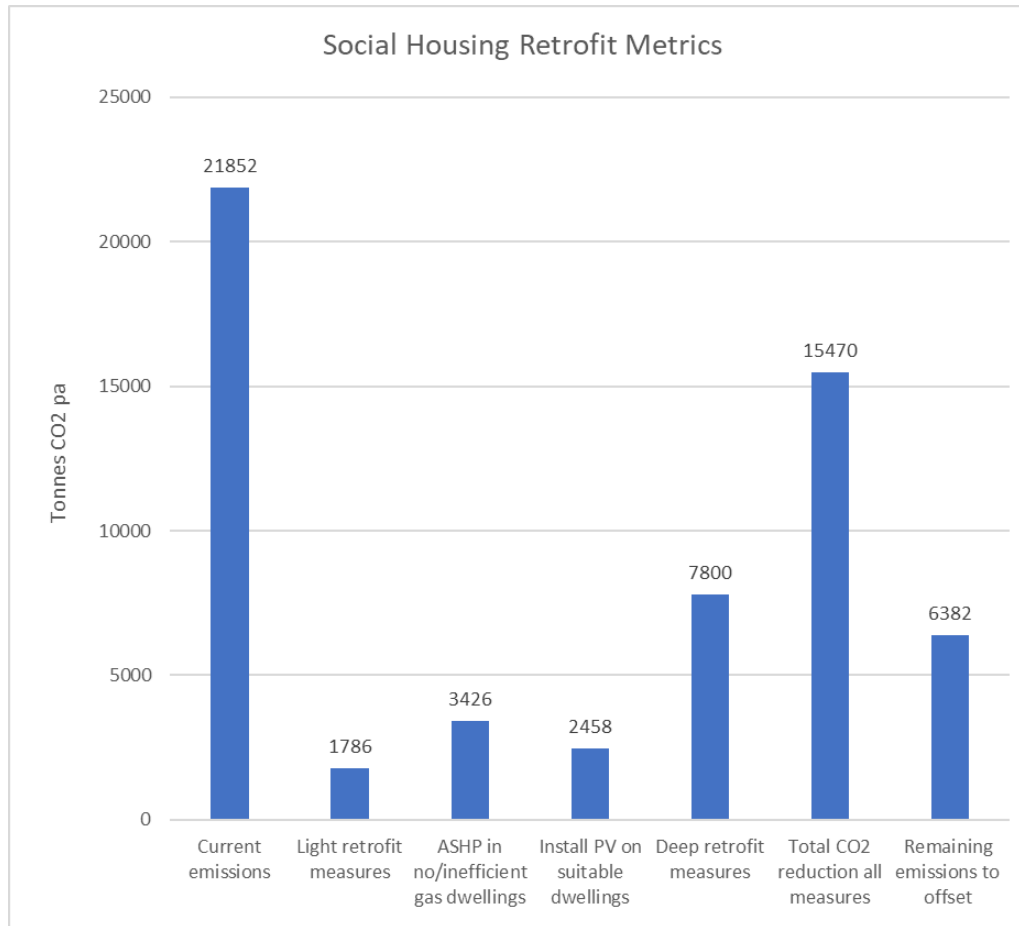

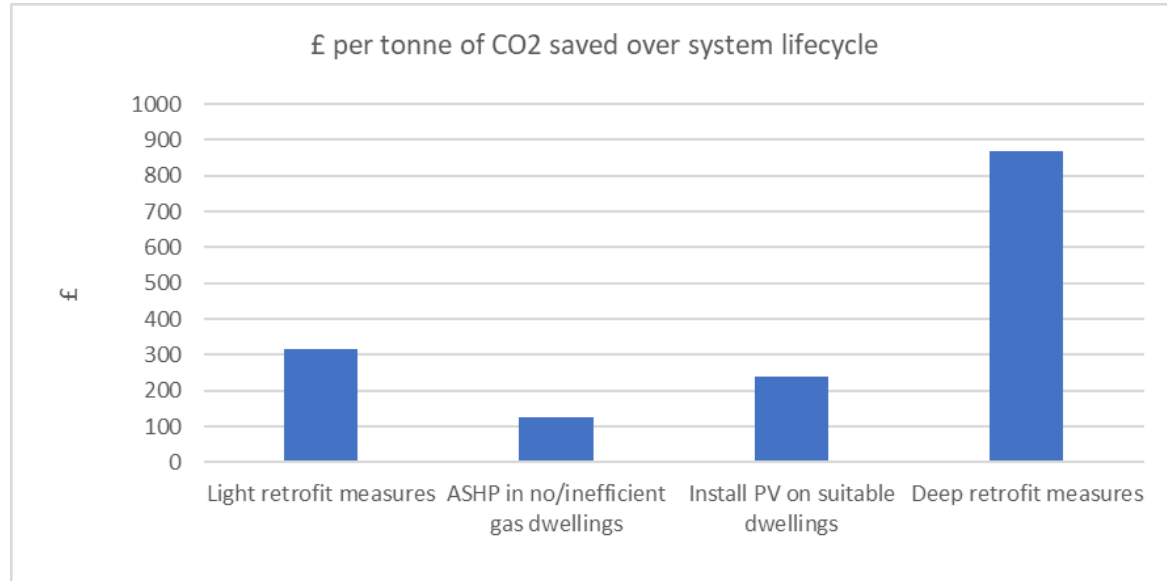
NCC Climate Action Plan – strategic areas of activity
