Report

- 1. In June 2008 the Conservators endorsed the Mousehold Heath Management Plan 2008-2013.
- 2. The plan set out a number of management objectives and proposed actions based upon a range of environmental, cultural and historical information and data, which identified the importance of Mousehold as an open space within the City.
- 3. The plan identified two broad management objectives which were to:
 - Ensure that the area is managed as effectively as possible to maintain and enhance its wildlife and historic value
 - Promote and enhance people's access to, and enjoyment of, the site
- 4. The plan also identified a set of management objectives which were:
 - Maintain, enhance and increase areas of heather and lowland heath vegetation
 - o Join existing areas of heathland vegetation
 - o Control encroachment by trees on open heathland areas
 - o Control bracken on open heath areas
 - o Maintain and enhance acid grassland areas
 - o Maintain and enhance areas of woodland selected for retention
 - o Maintain footpaths for public access
 - o Safeguard and improve management of the St. William's Chapel site
 - o Provide interpretation on history and natural history of site
 - Increase public understanding of issues relating to conservation of lowland heaths
 - Encourage sympathetic use of the site by the public through informal recreation and education
 - Discourage misuse and antisocial behaviour by users, especially the setting fire of vegetation
- 5. These were used to frame a set of management themes which have been used to prepare an annual work programme. These are:
 - o Habitat management
 - Management of the historic environment
 - o Visitor management

- o Visitor infrastructure
- 6. The plan identified a 10 year work programme and best practice suggests that this be reviewed at year five as circumstances and opportunities can change.
- 7. The implementation of the plan has been influenced by the following:
 - The two Mousehold wardens undertaking a greater range of practical work that would have previously been carried out by contractors with budgetary implications. This has resulted in the Conservators budget being used more effectively
 - Increased involvement from volunteers including work carried out by the Mousehold Defenders, groups such as TCV and various one off activities
 - Access to Government environmental grant income, which have now been reduced due to public sector budget reductions??????????
 - Increased events and guide walks leading to a better understanding and use of the heath by residents across the City of character and culture A more structured approach to biological data capture
 - o Increased partnership working
 - Available budgetary provision which is allocated through a precept that the Conservators make on the City Council
 - Others???????????????
- 8. A high level review of the plans implementation has been prepared which is included in appendix 1. This identifies progress against the main objectives, reasons for any change and recommendations for years six to ten.
- 9. Based on the level of resources available to the council, the Conservators are requested to:
 - o Discuss and consider progress
 - o Review the specific works recommendations where these have been provided
 - o Identify any areas that should prioritised during the next five years
 - Request officers bring the final revised plan to the January meeting of the Conservators, together with a costed work programme for 2013-14 for approval.
- 10. The final plan will be uploaded onto the Mousehold section of the council's website so that it can be accessed by residents and partners.
