We have appreciated the support which the twinning Committee has given us in the 50th Anniversary year of the friendship between our two cities. Our charity concert was an overwhelming success. The two pianists from Novi Sad played to a full house and from the proceeds of the concert we have been able to support a very worthwhile paper-making workshop project at the Milan Petrovic School for young people with a range of special needs. NNNSA members visited Novi Sad during the year to see at first hand the valuable work of the school and its workshops.

The concert is an important occasion for the Association and in the music calendar of our city. In particular, it raises awareness of our twin city to a variety of people who perhaps, know very little about Novi Sad and its culture. By raising funds for a specific educational project we continue to offer the hand of friendship. This coming year's concert will be performed by a male quartet of singers from St George's Cathedral Choir in Novi Sad who are presenting a programme of spiritual and secular songs, linking early English music with traditional Serbian Orthodox singing and including Balkan songs and instruments. Some of the singers may be known to a Norwich audience from the last visit of the choir to Norwich in 2001.

We do our own fund-raising, but with the increased costs of organising a charity concert, as a voluntary group we should be grateful for any support which the Twinning Committee is able to give the Association.
