## **Recent Issues & Management Work**

- 1. The planned St. James' Hill steps have been installed on the existing unofficial path that leads up to the Mottram Memorial from behind the Kett's Tavern, with the work being undertaken by BTCV.
- 2. The final winter period management work included the further opening up of the Cavalry Track by the Mousehold Heath Defenders.
- 3. Options are being investigated for the replacement of the existing lifeexpired Fountain Ground changing room. A meeting with the Football Foundation to explore if grant aid might be available to help fund the new facility) was due to take place on 11 June 2010.
- 4. Remedial work has been undertaken on all the main car parks at Mousehold.
- 5. On 28 April 2010, the exterior of the Pavilion ('Zak's') was inspected by Councillor Bearman and Chris Southgate of the Mousehold Heath Conservators accompanied by Kate d'Este Hoare, Norwich City Council's Design and Conservation Officer. The need for some external repairs was identified, as well as the possibility of a 'local listing' for the building.
- 6. A varied range of events has been planned by the Mousehold Heath Defenders and the Mousehold Wardens. The Defenders events have included, or will include:
  - St George's Day celebration
  - Early Bird Dawn Chorus walk
  - Spring walk
  - Art Day
  - Summer Solstice celebration
  - Winter Solstice celebration
- 7. A draft of the 2010 Guided Walks programme, as organised by the Mousehold Heath Wardens, is attached in Appendix A. Although all the walks are free, some of them have limited places so these will need to be booked in advance via the Norwich Tourist Information Centre.
- 8. The first of three summer band concerts at Mousehold took place on Sunday 6 June 2010.
