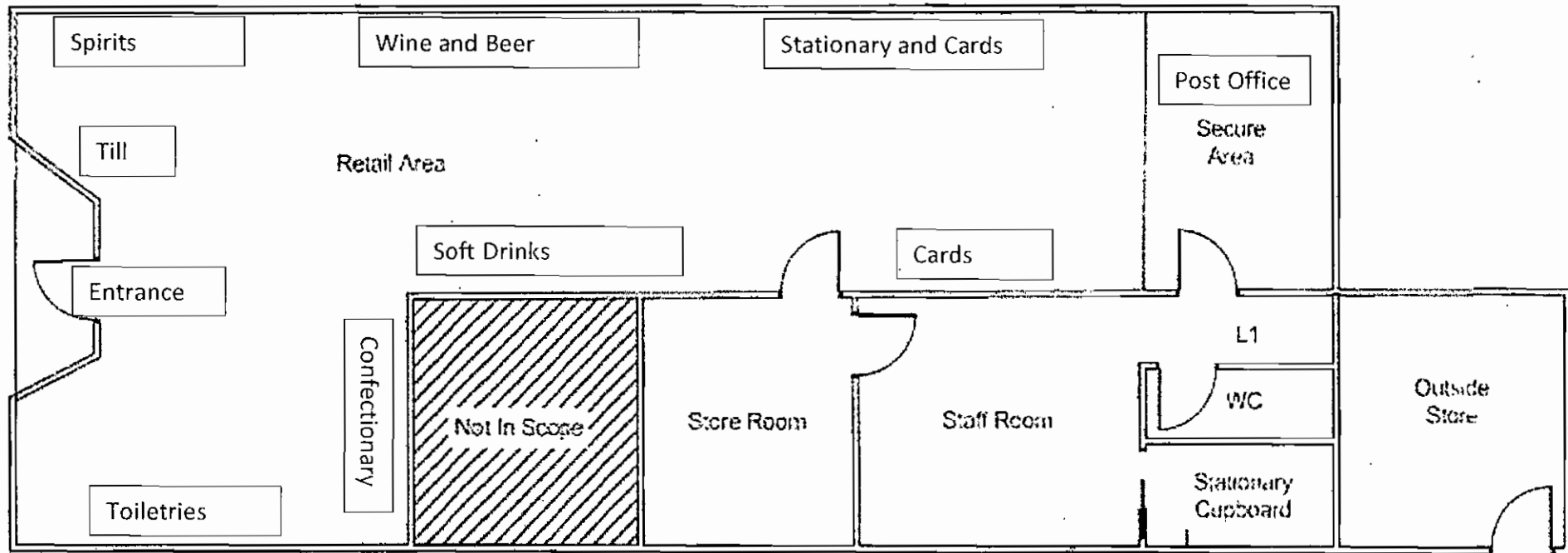

To Whom It May Concern

Should the post office be allowed to open for alcohol sales from 6am - 11pm seven days a week it will inevitably lead to undesirable people hanging around this area both early and late in the day which may well lead to more crime in this area. We have recently had two break ins and an armed robbery in this parade. We have now got a beggar who sits by the cash machine and if there is alcohol available so early we will probably get more.

From a personal point of view, since the death of my husband last year, I open up the newsagents at 5am each day by myself and thus provide a service for the early starters - I occasionally get people in search of alcohol and they are, without exception, quite aggressive. If alcohol is going to be sold so early they will be hanging around from earlier and I am not sure that I will feel safe on my own in the shop. The only people looking to buy alcohol at 6am will be the alcoholics and, once it becomes known, they will be here before 6am which will probably lead to trouble for me.

We already have two out of the fifteen shops selling alcohol so fail to see why we need another.

I also live above the shops and do not like the idea of a shop selling alcohol staying open till 11pm right where I live. The extra noise at night will not be good especially as I get up at 4am.

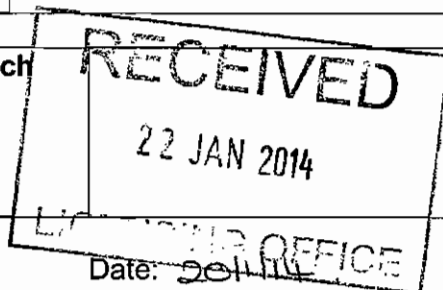

To prevent crime and disorder	I fear that with the Post Office and betting Shop being 2 doors from each other this will increase, noise and generally the combination of the two will cause disorder.
Public safety	Parking is limited at the front of the shops. The licence approval may lead to increased customers as parking is not adequate. There are lots of children in the area which makes it unsafe when people park on the pavements and in unauthorised places.
To prevent public nuisance	At present there are many 'alcoholics' that congregate outside the shops that serve alcohol and the betting shop. The crowds will normally disappear after closing time. The requested opening hours are much longer than the post office so this would worsen
To protect children from harm	To prevent under age and young adults from lingering around trying to purchase alcohol.
