Report

- 1. Under Section 8(2) of the Representation of the People Act 1983, the council must appoint to the position of Electoral Registration Officer. This position is responsible for maintaining the electoral register for the area.
- In England, the Electoral Registration Officer is also responsible for electoral registration for any parliamentary constituency situated in the local authority area. It is important to note that the Electoral Registration Officer is also required to discharge the responsibilities of Acting Returning Officer at UK Parliamentary elections.
- 3. The chief executive officer is currently the local returning officer for all other elections and local counting officer for referendums.
- 4. Traditionally a local authority will appoint its chief executive officer as the Electoral Registration Officer. The recommendation brings Norwich City Council in line with the majority of other local councils.
- 5. The recommendation will combine all responsibilities for the conduct of elections and electoral registration under one post holder.
