- 1. The appointments of chair of scrutiny committee and vice chair of norwich highways agency committee are usually made at the annual general meeting.
- Following the elections held in September, 2010 as a result of the high court judgement regarding unitary status, new political balance came into effect. Political groups made apointments to the revised overall membership of committees and working parties.
- 3. The council's constitution requires the chair of scrutiny to be drawn from a minority group. Following the election the green group nominated councillor Stephenson as the new chair. Other group leaders agreed that it was appropriate that this appointment commence straight away and councillor Stephenson has acted as chair of scrutiny committee since 14 September, 2010.
