Subject	Highways Act 1980: Application for Licence to Place Tables and Chairs on the Highway - Bella Italia, 3 Red Lion Street, Norwich, NR1 3QF	

Purpose

To ask members to consider an application to place tables and chairs on the highway.

Recommendation

That members determine the application to place tables and chairs on the highway submitted in respect of Bella Italia 3 Red Lion Street Norwich NR1 3QF.

Corporate and service priorities

The report helps to meet the corporate priority of a safe and clean city and the service plan priority of protecting the interests of the public through the administration of the licensing function. The provision of outdoor refreshment facilities can enhance the character and vitality of an area and contribute to Norwich as a vibrant city of culture.

Report

Background

1. Section 115E of the Highways Act 1980 (The Act) provides for a council to grant a person permission to use objects or structures on certain categories of highway for a purpose which will result in the production of income.
2. The Act also provides for a council to attach such conditions as they think fit to a permission granted under Section 115E. The council has adopted standard conditions in respect of permissions to use objects or structures on the highway and these are attached as appendix A to the report.
3. The Act gives councils a wide discretion to determine such applications and to impose conditions. Each case must be considered on its own merits with due weight being given to relevant considerations only. Existing policies or guidelines should not be applied so rigidly that an exercise of discretion in each individual case is precluded. Accordingly, the adopted standard conditions could be added to or amended depending on the circumstances of each individual application.

The application

4. An application submitted in respect of Bella Italia 3 Red Lion Street Norwich NR1 3QF originally sought to place 6 tables and 12 chairs on the highway between the hours of 08:00 and 22:00 Monday to Sunday. A copy of that application and accompanying photographs are attached at appendix B to the report.
5. Following consultation with the council's transport planning team (attached at appendix C to the report), the applicant's legal representative subsequently amended the application as follows:
 - reduction of tables from 6 to 4;
 - reduction in chairs from 12 to 8;
 - new barriers comprising of "L" shaped barriers at either end and two times 800mm sections along the frontage;
 - revised layout drawing (copy attached at appendix D) showing the reduction in the numbers of tables and chairs and a new barrier arrangement
 - removal of Sundays from the application altogether;
 - on Mondays to Saturdays the hours sought have been amended to:
 - 08:00 – 17:00 between 1 October and 30 April; and
 - 08:00 – 21:00 between 1 May and 30 September.

Consultation

6. In accordance with The Act, occupiers of nearby premises have been consulted and appropriate notices have been placed on the street. Notification of the application has

also been given to Chatterbox (the talking newspaper for the visually impaired) and the Norwich Access Group.

7. Details of the application have also been forwarded to the Norfolk Constabulary, Norfolk Fire Service and the City Council's Planning, Transportation and Landscape, Health and Safety and Pollution Control sections for comment.

Comments / objections / support

8. Representations have been received in respect of the original application from the following and are attached at appendix E to the report:

- two local businesses;
- two local residents;
- the Norfolk Fire Service;
- the Norfolk Constabulary's licensing and traffic management teams;
- and the Norwich Access Group.

Tables and Chairs Licence – Standard Conditions

- 1 The Council's reasonable expenses in connection with the granting of this permission shall have been paid and the annual fee starting with the date of this permission shall have been paid before the permission is first exercised.
- 2 The Licensee shall indemnify the Council against any claim whatsoever, in respect of injury, damage or loss arising out of the grant of this permission other than injury, damage or loss which is attributable to the negligence of the Council.
- 3 The objects or structures shall be placed only on the licensed area and on no other part of the public highway.
- 4 The objects or structures shall be used only for the purposes stated above and only in connection with the premises.
- 5 The objects or structures shall be removed from the public highway forthwith upon the direction of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden.
- 6 The objects or structures shall be removed from the public highway forthwith to enable the passage of any emergency service vehicles or any vehicle engaged on the repair or maintenance of the public highway or apparatus within the public highway or any other vehicle authorised by the Council to proceed on the public highway.
- 7 Permission for the tables and chairs is granted from **(time of day/month of year) to (time of day/month of year)** (subject to earlier termination under clause 13).
- 8 No amplified music or live music shall take place on the licensed area.
- 9 The tables and chairs, the subject of this Licence, shall be removed from the licensed area each day outside of the licence period.
- 10 The Licensee shall ensure that the licensed area is mainly enclosed by a barrier that is in keeping with the visual appearance of the area, not less than 800mm high and with no more than 150mm between the base rail and the ground, or other design as previously agreed in writing by the Council. Neither the barrier nor other furniture should carry strident advertising that goes beyond the purpose of discreetly identifying that the pavement cafe is associated with a particular business.
- 11 The Licensee undertakes to ensure that the licensed area is closely monitored and kept clean and tidy at all times.

- 12 No alteration to the highway surface shall be permitted to be carried out by the Licensee in implementing this Licence
- 13 The Council may, by service of a notice in writing on the Licensee or owner of the premises, withdraw the Licence forthwith:-
 - (a) in an emergency or in the event that the Council considers the exercise of the Licence causes a substantial and unreasonable obstruction of the right of the public to pass or re-pass on the public highway,
 - (b) if any condition of this permission is broken,
 - (c) if the Council considers it to be necessary in connection with the exercise of any of its functions or the functions of any statutory undertaker or public utility,
 - (d) for any other reasonable cause.
- 14 The Licensee shall inform the Council's Head of Citywide Services in writing of any change in the owner or occupier of the premises within one month of that change.
- 15 This permission is for tables and chairs and barriers only. No other items, for example space heaters, are permitted by this licence.

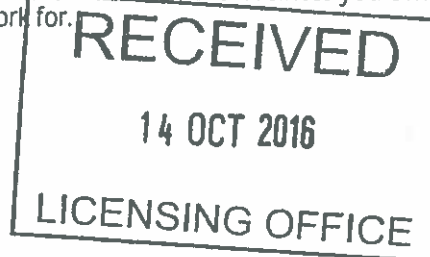

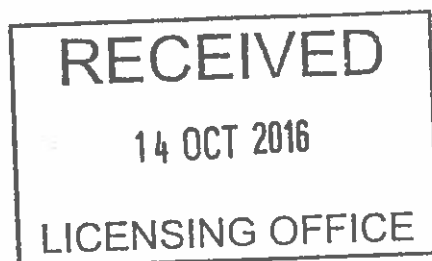

Hi Jeremy,

In view of the changes outlined below I support this application for seating at Bella Italia.

I believe the change to the timings that have been made will avoid issues with peak passenger queues from the nearby stop for University buses 25, 26 and 26A. At normal peak pedestrian levels there is sufficient width to accommodate the amended seating arrangement and allow safe use of the footway and crossing movements. On a day-to-day level, it would be preferable if any A-board was placed as close as is reasonably possible to the seating barriers and contacts the building, this is subject to any other specific requirements of our A-board policy for businesses. Looking at the positives as well as the concerns; this seating area has the potential to compliment the message that this area of the city is largely for people to enjoy spending time.

Operating this for 12 months will enable us to review if this is functioning as hoped for all users of the footway.

Further to our recent emails and conversations (and once again many thanks to you both for your time), I wish to formally amend the application for tables and chairs in light of those discussions.

The application is to be amended as follows:

- New proposed layout drawing (copy attached) showing a reduction in the numbers of tables and chairs and a new barrier arrangement (which I understand you are both content with);
- Reduction of tables from 6 to 4;
- Reduction in chairs from 12 to 8;
- New barriers comprising of "L" shaped barriers at either end and two times 800mm sections along the frontage;
- Amend the times and days of operation, in light of the meeting with Ed, in the following way;
 - remove Sundays altogether;
 - on Mondays to Saturdays amend the hours as follows:

- o during the months of October to April (running from 1 October to 30 April) the hours of operation to be from 8am to 5pm; and
- o during the months of May to September (running from 1 May to 30 September) the hours of operation to be from 8am to 9pm.

I understand that Ed look at this and then confirm that he is content that the issues of concern have been addressed and that his objection is removed. Once that has been confirmed, I will write a letter/email to Ian which can be sent to the other objectors advising of the amendments and my client's willingness to meet with and/or discuss the application in person if that would be something the objectors wished to do.

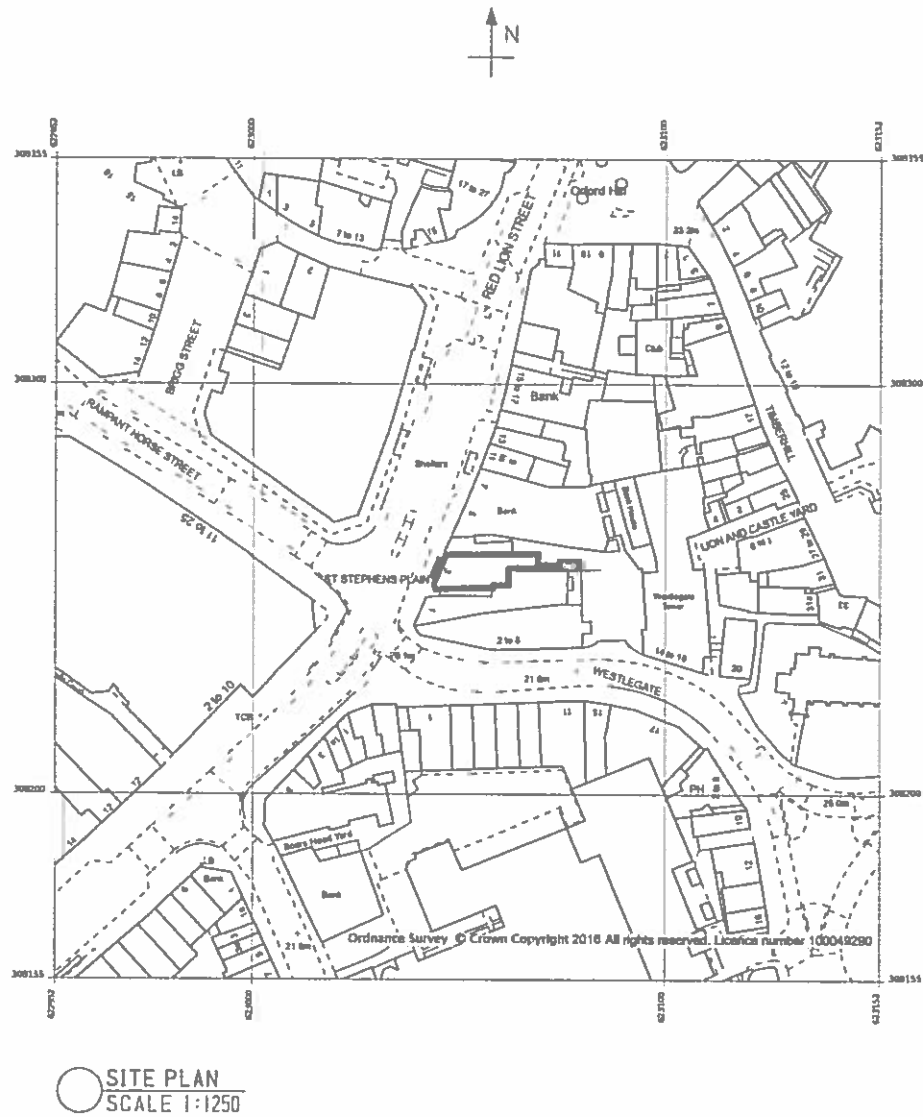

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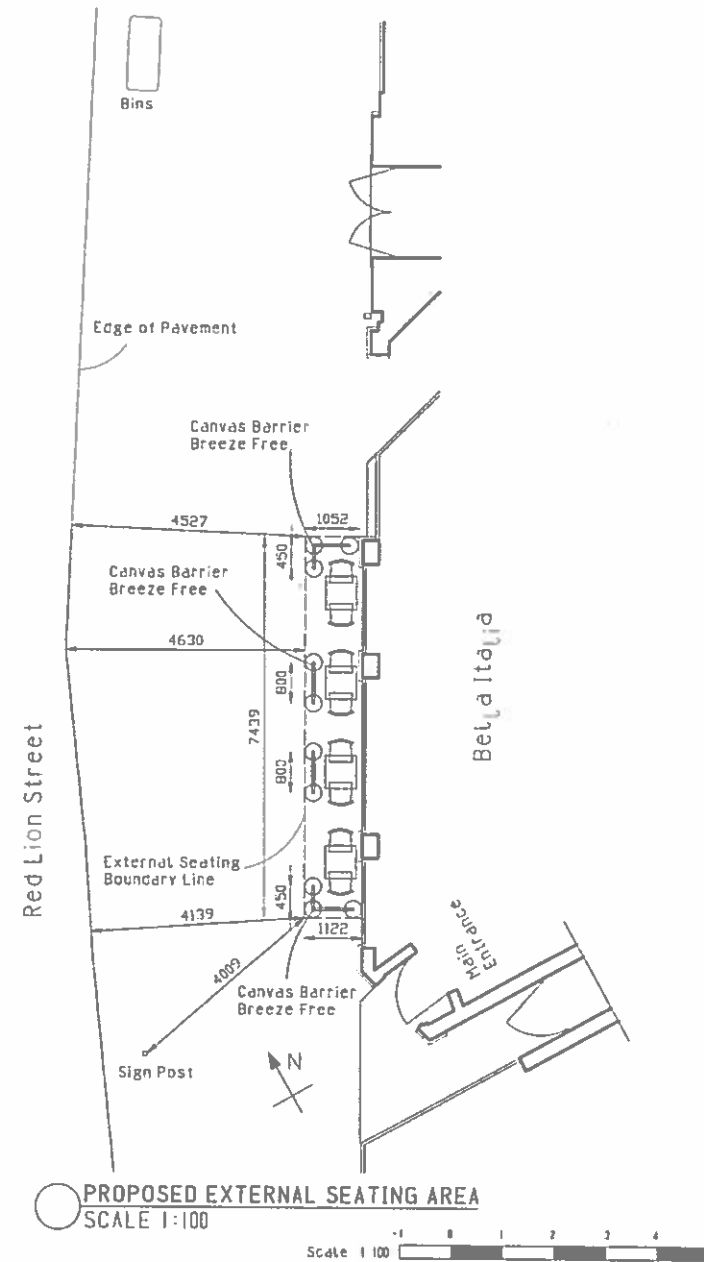

Dear Mr Streeter

We received your letters informing us of the application by Casual Dining Services Limited to allow outside tables for the premises of Bella Italia

We have several concerns. There is no similar facility along this part of the city centre. I understand that an application by the Five Guys restaurant was turned down because of concerns about sufficient walking areas, however no other restaurant or shop has outside seating directly on the highway area. Whilst it is a commercial area, it is also residential and the additional noise generated will transmit during the evening which I believe is not fair.

The second concern is that the transport planners decided to erect a bus stop facility outside of our building around 18 months ago. The facility has already reduced free-flow walking capacity on this side of the street, despite the widening of the pavement area.

The reason is very clear to see - I have attached photographs showing very large queues which often extend to and beyond Bella Italia and this will now become blocked with the additional of a bartered off area. I also don't think its particularly helpful for customers to have so many people in close proximity when you are trying to eat a meal.

Thirdly the tables will inevitably be used by those wishing to smoke. Whilst we do not have restrictions on smoking in purpose allocated areas outside, this will encourage more smoking pollution in an area that has already been affected by the positioning of the bus stop. It is unfair to expect residents to deal with additional smoking pollution over and above that arising from pedestrians. Despite what might be claimed, it does travel it does permeate through windows.

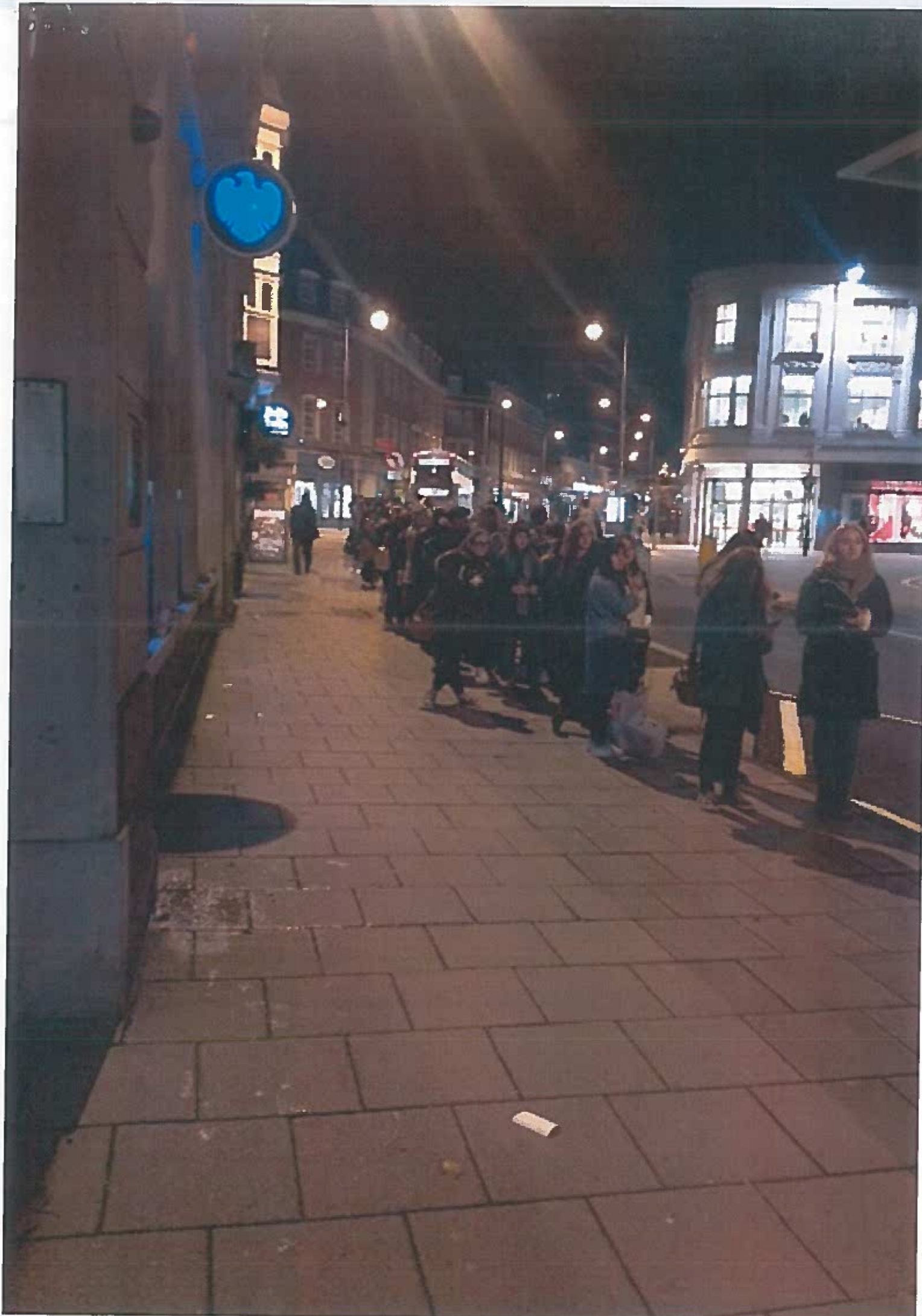
Finally, and most obviously, the tables will be serving alcohol. Again, we suggest that this is extending the outside areas in which alcohol is consumed beyond currently designated areas (such as Timber Hill) and creates a precedent for this area. It may or may not be the licensing/planners intention to encourage more evening entrainment areas in this part of the city - we would like to know if this is the case. However it will make attempts to restrict drinking in public spaces more difficult if others see alcohol readily drunk outside in public at an iconic junction of the city. Given the problems already experienced elsewhere, is it right to extend this risk into this area as well.

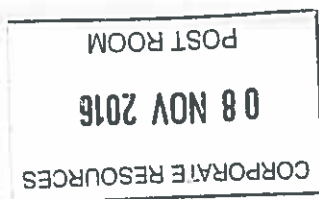
We don't wish to curtail business opportunities, but as it stands we don't believe this application should be granted without further consultation and consideration about the potential impacts
