The Committee's decision:

Members resolved to grant the Licence as applied for with the imposition of two further conditions on the Licence:-

- That to the extent the Licensee had control over the alleyway to the rear of the premises, not to use it for any purpose connected with the business other than storage of the refuse bin.
- That the Licensee must take all steps within its control to minimise the nuisance from persons using Exchange Street outside the licensed premises for smoking.

Reasons

 Members considered the application and noted that there were no representations from any of the responsible authorities. Members considered the concerns of the interested persons merited the imposition of the two further conditions.

Right of a Party to appeal against the determination of the Authority

For your information, applicants and any person who has submitted a relevant representation, or submitted an objection notice, who is aggrieved by the decision, or the imposition of any term, condition or restriction, have a right of appeal to the Magistrates' Court within 21 days of the date on which they are notified of the decision.
