## NOTICE OF DETERMINATION

Determination-; The Committee heard the application for a premises licence at the above premises. There were no objections from any of the responsible Authorities but representations have been made by interested parties. The main objections related to the regulated entertainment aspects of the application and the proposed opening hours due to the close proximity of the interested party's residences. There was also concern that the car park was physically unsafe.

The applicant, represented by Bruce Faulkner of Rogers & Norton, withdrew all the regulated entertainment aspects of the application and reduced his proposed opening hours to: Sunday-Monday 10:00 to 24:00hrs

Sale of alcohol Sunday to Monday 10:00 to 23:30hrs

Late night refreshment Sunday – Monday 10:00 to 24:00hrs.

Also offered as part of the operating schedule were the conditions that Patrons not sat and ready to eat by 23:00hrs will be turned away and that no bottles would be deposited outside the building after 22:00hrs.

The Committee's Decision:

**The committee granted the licence as set out in the applicants amended operating schedule above.**

The Committee's reasons:

The Committee took into account the objections voiced by interested parties and the applicants response. The concerns voiced by the interested parties in relation to the car park and fence were noted but these are planning aspects and not to be considered by the Committee, however the applicants legal representative stated he would look at this with his client. Following the applicant amending the operating schedule the Committee believed that the conditions offered addressed the concerns of interested parties and promoted the licensing objectives.

Right of a Party to appeal against the determination of the Authority.

**For your information, applicants and any party who made a relevant objection, or submitted an objection notice, who is aggrieved by the decision, or the imposition of any term, condition or restriction, have a right of appeal to the Magistrates Court within 21 days of the date on which they are notified of the decision.**
