

**Local Government (Executive Arrangements)(Meetings and Access to Information)
(England) Regulations 2012.**

A 'key decision' means a decision which is likely to either:-

(a) result in the council incurring expenditure which is, or making savings which are, significant in relation to the council's total budget for the service or function to which the decision relates (for these purposes the presumption is that "significant" means any sum exceeding whichever is greater of the thresholds established by the European public procurement directive 2014/24/EU for local government in respect of contracts for supplies or services), or;

(b) be significant in terms of its effects on communities living or working in an area comprising two or more wards or electoral divisions in the Norwich city area.
