Representations

One further letter received objecting to the proposal, citing the following:

- 1. The existing location of the health centre is an ideally situated central service for all local people that is easily accessible.
- To move it would be an unnecessary cost to an already overstretched National Health Service. Furthermore, it forces the centre into a bigger and unnecessary long term financial commitment.
- 3. There have been previous restaurants that have experienced mixed success and there is no guarantee of financial success for the proposed venture.
- 4. Level 4 has poor natural light and is not an attractive restaurant venue. It serves its current utilitarian service well.

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Updates to report

It is felt that paragraphs 10, 23 and 30 of the report need calrification. These state that block B to the rear of the site is higher than previously approved, however this was amended during the course of the application to retain a ridge height the same as previously approved as detailed at paragraphs 25 and 32.

In relation to paragraph 30 it should be clarified that whilst the stepping of block B has been removed there is still some articulation in the frontage introduced by the central gable and it is not completely flat fronted.
