

Novi Sad and the Norfolk County Youth Orchestra

Irena Josifoska, the young cello player from Novi Sad was invited to play again with the Norfolk County Youth Orchestra, this time on their annual visit to Germany.

Irena, with the orchestra, gave a performance of the Elgar Cello Concerto. This was a work that both Irena and the orchestra were familiar with since they had performed it before in Cambridge.

The lead up to the event was not without its difficulty since, at almost the last minute, the lead viola was unable to attend. Since the viola part is very important, not least in the concerto, this proved to be a problem - particularly since a substitute could not be found.

An anxious call to Irena by the organisation to see if there was an appropriate young viola player from Novi Sad who could 'take up' the part was met with an enthusiastic and positive response the upshot of which resulted in two players travelling from Novi

Sad to Wernegerode (an adventure in itself).

The series of concerts performed were a great success with a connection between the Norfolk Youth Orchestra and young Novi Sad musicians becoming a pleasant habit.

The present refugee crisis in Serbia

The crisis of refugees from Syria and other countries travelling through Serbia has brought an empathetic response from the Serbian population.

Apart from essential medical and hygiene items Novi Sad responded with one and a half tons of clothing and food for the refugees - all within about 24 hours.
