Cabinet Meeting - 13 October 2021

On 13 October 2021 the cabinet will be considering a key decision regarding the refurbishment of Carrow House, which will include an exempt appendix.

This item has been added to the agenda with less than 5 clear days notice, and accordingly the chair of scrutiny has given their permission for the cabinet to consider this item.

This item cannot be reasonably deferred as to do so would place the council at a significant disadvantage. The exempt appendix will include material that is of a commercially sensitive nature.
