QueerFest for **Interrupt**, an exhibition of contemporary art to be shown in the Shoe Factory Social Club, 8 - 25 February 2024. The intention of Interrupt is to challenge the heteronormative gaze and elicit stories of a Queer experience.

Unconsumed. Unconsumed II is a group exhibition of around 100 artists, either East Anglia-based or with a strong connection to the region, taking place from 27 May - 12 June 2024. Multi-generational, cross-disciplinary and championing inclusivity, this will be an exciting showcase of our local creative talent.

Grace Adam for the creation of a body of work for an exhibition at Mandells Gallery from 10 - 31 August 2024. The central theme of the work is flint: its histories, geometries and forms.
