### **Our Aims & Objectives**

Established in 1974 Leeway today works across Norfolk and Suffolk, supporting adults, children and young people affected by domestic abuse.

During 2017 to 2018 in one 12 month period we supported almost 11,000 people

A grant from Norwich City Council of £100 helped Leeway to set up our first refuge in 1974 and this was one of the first to open in the Country.
