#### Annex 1 – Mandatory conditions

1 No supply of alcohol may be made under a premises licence -

> (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or

(b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who

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holds a personal licence. The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder must ensure that an age (1)

verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

The designated premises supervisor in relation to the premises licences must ensure that (2)the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy. The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 (3)

years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either:-(a) a holographic mark or

(b) an ultraviolet feature.

A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off

the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price. For the purposes of the condition set out in paragraph 1:

(a) "duty" is to be construed in accordance with the Alcoholic Liquor Duties Act 1979

(b) "permitted price" is the price found by applying the formula:

P = D + (DxV)Where:

(i)P is the permitted price

D is the amount of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were charged on (ii) the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol, and

V is the rate of value added tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the value added (iii) tax were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol;

"relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a (c) premises licence:

(i) The holder of the premises licence

The designated premises supervisor (if any) in respect of such a licence, or (ii)

The personal licence holder who makes or authorises a supply of alcohol under such a (iii) licence;

(d) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a club premises certificate, any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables the member or officer to prevent the supply in question; and

"value added tax" means value added tax charged in accordance with the Value Added Tax (e) Act 1994.

(1)Sub-paragraph (2) applies where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 on a day ("the first day") would be different from the permitted price on the next day ("the second day") as a result of a change to the rate of duty or value added tax.

The permitted price which would apply on the first day applies to sales or supplies (2) of alcohol which take place before the expiry of the period of 14 days beginning on the second day.

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# Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

- 1 General all four licensing objectives
- 2 ID will be checked.
- 3 There will be no underage sales.
- 4 The Prevention of Crime and Disorder
- 5 Customers will be asked to leave the premises quietly. If they do not then the Police will be contacted.
- 6 There will be two members of staff working at the same time in the evenings.
- 7 A Challenge 25 Policy will be in operation.
- 8 CCTV to be in operation and to record for a minimum of 28 days and for footage to be available to Police or Licensing Authority on request.
- 9 A refusal book will be kept on the premises to record all refused sales. This book will be available to Police and Licensing Authority on request.
- 10 Staff will be trained in relation to the sale of alcohol and a record of this training will be kept and made available to Police and Licensing Authority on request.



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
