## Supplemental Addendum to Cabinet report dated 23/2/22: Renewal of Microsoft Enterprise Licenses

Following the meeting of Cabinet on 23/2/22 to consider the award of a contract for Microsoft Enterprise Licenses, queries have been raised regarding the details of the contract and in that regard, this further information is being published to aid understanding of the size of the contract being entered into by the Council.

Norwich City Council provides IT services to support its staff and Councillors in the undertaking of its work. It also provides IT services to Norwich City Services Ltd. This means that in total, there is a headcount of over 1,100 individuals that are required to access Microsoft applications and software. In addition, the Council is required to purchase licences for specific software including PowerBI, Project and Visio, and software for meeting rooms.
