Background

- 1. The council requires a wide area network (WAN) to cover all council buildings in respect of external network and internet services
- 2. The WAN is the telecommunications network that supports all of our external communications structure.
- 3. The council is currently in contract with Updata Infrastructure UK Limited.
- 4. This contract was awarded under a Norfolk County Council framework and expires on the 31 March 2020.
- 5. A new contract is required for continuity of service. Therefore the new contract is required to start on 1 April 2020 and will expire on 31 March 2024.

Procurement Process

- 6. The Norfolk County Council framework has been confirmed to continue for a further four year period.
- 7. Use of a framework ensures the procurement is compliant with the Public Contract Regulations 2015. The supplier offering these services are accredited to the framework and have already been vetted and overall capability proven.
- 8. Updata Infrastructure UK Limited, the incumbent, is the only supplier on this framework
- 9. No issues have been identified with the service provided by the incumbent and an award under the framework will satisfy the both the legislation and the council's contract procedures.

Recommendation

- 10. To award the contract to Updata Infrastructure UK Limited
- 11. The total awarded value is £260,000 for the full four year contract
