

Notice of Determination

Determination -

The Committee noted that following consultation with the council's pollution and enforcement section, the applicant had agreed to the following conditions being attached to their licence.

- 1. Playing of recorded music will be restricted to indoors only.
- 2. The hatched outside area marked on the plan at appendix C, will be closed between 2230hrs and 0800hrs the following day.

The Committee also noted that the landlord will encourage customers who smoke to use the premises at the rear of the public house and will encourage customers waiting for taxi cabs to remain inside the premises until the cabs arrive.

The Committee's decision:

The Committee granted the sought variation and therefore agreed:

- To extend the opening hours of the premises so that on Monday to Thursday the premises close at 0100hrs the following day and on Friday and Saturday the premises close at 0130hrs the following day. The premises will be open on Sundays from 1100hrs.
- 2. To extend the hours for the sale of alcohol on Monday to Thursday to

0030hrs the following morning and on Friday and Saturday to 0100hrs the following morning.

- 3. To extend the hours for the provision of late night refreshment on Monday to Thursday until 0030hrs the following morning and on Friday and Saturday to 0100hrs the following morning.
- 4. That there are the following seasonal variations:

In respect of the sale of alcohol and provision of late night refreshment, on Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, Boxing Day, New Year's Day, on all Bank Holidays, on Easter Sunday, Easter Monday and the day preceding a Bank Holiday hours are extended until 0100hrs the following day.

The hours for the sale of alcohol and provision of late night refreshment are extended from the end of permitted hours on New Year's Eve to the start of permitted hours on New Year's Day.

On the morning on which summertime begins, where the terminal hour is later than 0100hrs the terminal hour shall be extended by 1 hour in respect of the provision of late night refreshment and the sale of alcohol.

The opening hours of the premises are extended to 0130hrs the following day on the seasonal variation days specified in this clause 4.

5. That the premises may be used for the licensable activities of the provision of facilities for making music (indoors only) and the provision of facilities for dancing (indoors only) on the following days and times:

Monday to Thursday, 2000hrs to 2200hrs Friday and Saturday, 2000hrs to 2300hrs Sundays 2000hrs to 2200hrs

- 6. That the plan showing the extent of the licensed area is amended to include the external drinking area and smoking shelter marked on Plan at appendix C.
- 7. That condition No 8 on Annexe 2 of the premises licence is removed.

The Committee's reasons:

The reasons for the Committee's decision were:-

There were no representations received from the responsible authorities.

There was no evidence to support a view that noise complained of in the street outside the premises emanated from the Ten Bells and/or was within the control of the licensee.

That considering all the evidence before the committee, the licensing objectives

would be promoted by the approved variation.

Right of a Party to appeal against the determination of the Authority

For your information, applicants and any party who made a relevant representation, or submitted an objection notice, who is aggrieved by the decision, or the imposition of any term, condition or restriction, have a right of appeal to the Magistrates' Court within 21 days of the date on which they are notified with a decision.
