## Report

#### **Background**

- 1. The County Council has allocated funds for highway maintenance and improvement works in the current financial year. In addition, there are works associated with several new developments, which has lead to a significant amount of highway works in and around the city centre. These works have been carefully programmed to minimise as far as possible the impact on pedestrians and traffic. When necessary, appropriate diversions will be put in place and signed.
- 2. In addition to programmed highways works, Utilities Companies are permitted to carry out works to repair and replace their mains and cables in the adopted public highway.
- 3. Despite the long-term benefits that accrue from works to upgrade and improve the condition of the Utilities Companies services and the public highway, the act of carrying out these works is viewed as a major inconvenience and source of annoyance to the travelling public. As far as possible, all works are coordinated to minimise disruption.
- 4. As part of the process to provide the travelling public with better information on the extent of on-going and proposed major roadworks, a weekly summary is sent via the County Council to the Police, AA, RAC and national and local media for inclusion in roadworks reports on television, radio and local newspapers.
- 5. This summary forms the basis of the appended report for monitoring of major roadworks in and around the City. Also attached is a schedule of the major schemes in and around the city centre showing programmes of works as far as is currently known.
