**Application for the grant of a premises licence under the Licensing Act 2003**

**Determination**

The Committee considered an application for the grant of a premises licence for Cook Mama restaurant, 19 Fye Bridge Street, Norwich, NR3 1LJ as detailed in the exempt agenda papers, following the receipt of relevant representation.

The committee heard evidence from the applicant, the applicant's agent and a representative of a responsible authority, all of whom answered questions raised by Members.

After due consideration and taking into account all the information provided to it prior to the hearing and the submissions made by all parties at the hearing, and having regard to the Home Office statutory guidance, as well as the council's own licensing policy, it was

**RESOLVED:**

(Unanimously) to grant the application as applied for, incorporating the amendments to the operating schedule as agreed by the applicant at the hearing. The committee saw no evidence to suggest that the licensing objectives would be undermined by the granting of the licence as applied for. The committee noted the availability of the licence review procedure.

Any appeal against the committee's decision is to be submitted to the Magistrates court within 21 days of the date on which the interested party is notified of the committee's decision.

## ANNEX A - OPERATING SCHEDULE AMENDMENTS

### Amendments to the Operating Schedule offered by the applicant:

1. The following amendments to be made to the first paragraph of the operating schedule (steps to promote all four licensing objectives together):
  - i. **Replace** 'Alcohol will only be served as ancillary to food' **with** '*Alcohol will only be served with a substantial food order*'
2. The following amendments to be made to the second paragraph of the operating schedule (The prevention of crime and disorder):
  - i. **Replace** 'CCTV will be at use at the premises, it is maintained by the landlord for the building, and covers all licensable activity area for the premises.' **with** '*CCTV will be at use at the premises, it is maintained by the landlord for the building, and covers all licensable activity area for the premises. CCTV to record for a minimum of 28 days and be available to the Police or Licensing Authority on request.*'
  - ii. **Replace** 'To record all instances of disorder, damage to property and personal injury at the premises.' **with** '*Records of all instances of disorder, damage to the property and personal injury to staff and customers at the premises will be kept at the premises.*'
