Agenda Item 7: Adoption of the Greater Norwich Local Plan – Information on additional modifications and cabinet report corrections

- 1. Additional (minor) modifications can be made to a local plan any time up to its adoption. The following additional modifications have been made to the online GNLP since publication of the Cabinet papers:
 - Paragraph 23 of the GNLP Strategy (<u>J2.1</u>) has been amended to reflect the information on the completion of the Diss and area plan referenced in the table in appendix 3 of the GNLP Strategy, so that paragraph 23 now reads (revised text in italics):
 - and the Diss, Scole and Burston area, for which a Neighbourhood Plan has been produced which allocates sites.
 - To reflect the text in paragraph 23, the fourth bullet point in appendix 3 of the GNLP Strategy (<u>J2.1</u>) and the same text in the introductions to the Policies Map booklets (<u>J3.1</u>, <u>J3.2</u> and <u>J3.3</u>) have been changed so that they now read (new text in italics):
 - "South Norfolk Local Plan Site-Specific Allocations and Policies Document (2015) except for the smaller villages in South Norfolk that will be addressed through a new South Norfolk Village Clusters Housing Allocations Local Plan".
- 2. Two corrections are required to the cabinet report which are already included in the full council report:
 - The GNLP housing figure in paragraph 18 on page 105 of the cabinet papers should be 45,050 new homes (not 45,500).
 - Paragraph 20 on page 106 should state that the GNLP provides the great majority of employment land on strategic scale sites (not all 360 hectares).
