### 1. APOLOGIES

There were no apologies.

### 2. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

There were no declarations of interest.

### 3. EXCLUSION OF PUBLIC

**RESOLVED** to exclude the public from the meeting during consideration of items 4 to 9 below on the grounds contained in paragraphs 1 and 3 of Part 1 of Schedule 12(A) of the Local Government Act 1972, as amended.

### **\*4. APPLICATION FOR GRANT OF A 12 MONTH PRIVATE HIRE DRIVER'S LICENCE CASE NO 14/00820/PHDRIV (PARAS 1 & 3)**

(The applicant attended the meeting for this item and was accompanied by his father. He confirmed that he had been informed of his right to be legally represented at the meeting but had chosen not to be. He produced his DVLA licence for inspection by the committee. He also confirmed that since the application form was completed, he had received no further convictions or cautions and that he had no matters pending.)

The licensing manager presented the report.

The applicant explained the circumstances surrounding his caution for possession of a class A drug which he had received on 15 December 2012. Following solicitor's advice, he accepted a caution for possession in order to bring the matter to a swift close.

The applicant confirmed that the incident was not related to driving and that he had a driving job lined up if his application was successful.

**\*5. APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL OF A PRIVATE HIRE DRIVER'S LICENCE  
CASE NO 14/00590/PHDRIV (PARAS 1 & 3)**

He produced his DVLA licence for inspection by the committee. The licensing manager produced a copy of the applicant's DVLA licence for inspection by the committee. The applicant also confirmed that since the application form was completed, he had received no further convictions or cautions and that he had no matters pending.)

The licensing manager presented the report.

The applicant explained the circumstances surrounding his convictions for exceeding the statutory speed limit on a public road which he had received on 21 June 2010 and 13 February 2013.

The licensing manager produced a copy of the applicant's DVLA licence for inspection by the committee. The applicant explained the circumstances surrounding his convictions for exceeding the statutory speed limit on a public road which he had received on 28 July 2013 and 2 November 2013.
