### 4 Draft Statement of Licensing Policy under the Licensing Act 2003 9 - 114

**Purpose** - To consider the revised draft Statement of Licensing Policy in respect of alcohol, regulated entertainment and late night refreshment under the Licensing Act 2003 and to recommend to Cabinet for consultation for 12 weeks from 11 May 2026 to 7 August 2026.
