### **Determination** -

The Committee noted that there was evidence of serious crime taking place on the premises.

#### The Committee's decision:

The Committee revoked the premises licence with immediate effect. Mr Siddiquee who was legally represented was informed of his right to appeal the decision.

#### The Committee's reasons:

That the DPS/Licence holder did not have sufficient control over the premises so as to achieve the promotion of the licensing objective of prevention of crime and disorder.

The Committee did not believe that a change of Designated Premises Supervisor as proposed by Mr Siddiquee would serve to address their concerns.

## Right of a Party to appeal against the determination of the Authority

For your information, applicants and any party who made a relevant representation, or submitted an objection notice, who is aggrieved by the decision, or the imposition of any term, condition or restriction, have a right of appeal to the Magistrates' Court within 21 days of the date on which they are notified of the decision.
