## Local Government (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012.

### Cabinet Meeting – 12 June 2019

In addition to the items published on the notice dated 15 May 2019, the additional matters listed below will be considered at the above meeting of cabinet, to be held at city hall, Norwich.

As required under the above regulations, the chair of the scrutiny committee has been advised that one item has been added to the agenda and the purpose of another item changed for the following reason:

The matter needs to be considered prior to the next meeting of cabinet in July 2019 and the change of purpose provides greater transparency to what is being discussed.

A 'key decision' means a decision which is likely to either:-

(a) result in the council incurring expenditure which is, or making savings which are, significant in relation to the council's total budget for the service or function to which the decision relates (for these purposes the presumption is that "significant" means any sum exceeding whichever is greater of the thresholds established by the European public procurement directive 2014/24/EU for local government in respect of contracts for supplies or services), or;

(b) be significant in terms of its effects on communities living or working in an area comprising two or more wards or electoral divisions in the Norwich city area.
