Introduction

- 1. Members will be aware of the High Court decision on 5 July 2010 quashing The Norfolk Structural Changes Order. This removed, with immediate effect, the thirteen councillors whose terms of office had been extended by the order to May, 2011.
- 2. Four portfolio holders were amongst the thirteen and the Executive has been operating with only four members. This report recommends bringing the Executive back to its normal size of eight members.
