Programme changes arising from the 25% in year reduction in integrated transport block funding

- 8. The coalition Government has confirmed a 25% reduction in the integrated transport block funding in 2010/11 as part of its approach to deficit recovery. The integrated transport block funds the Local Transport Plan (LTP) programme and therefore the reduction will have an effect on the capital programme bid for and monitored by this committee.
- 9. Officers of the city and county council have considered options of how best to achieve such an in year saving giving existing commitments and the work carried out to either develop or partly implement schemes in 2010/11 already. These options form part of an overall package of recommendations to deliver a 25% saving in the County Council's overall LTP improvement programme which was considered by the County Council's cabinet at their meeting on 12 July 2010. The cabinet agreed to recommend the proposals to Council (which meets on 26 July). The changes as they affect this year's programme for Norwich are shown in the table over the page.
